Modernize teaching content

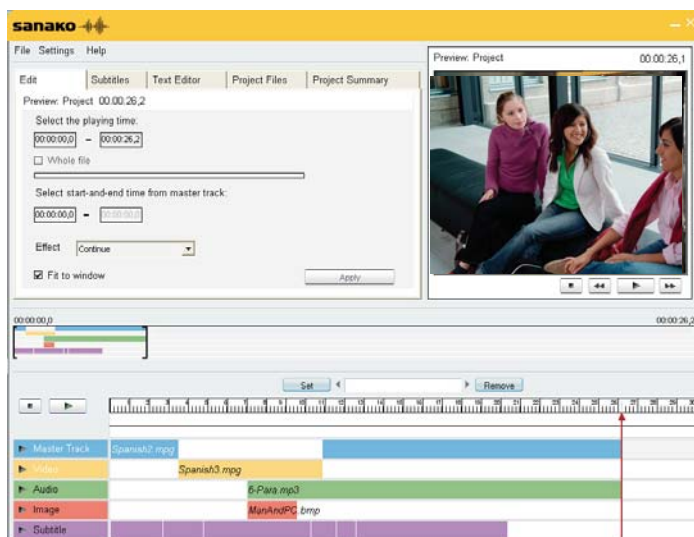
The Study Content Authoring Module offers a variety of different media formats that teachers can easily incorporate into learning material. Once the content has been created, all the lesson materials can be saved as a single file making storage and usage of the material as easy as possible. Additionally, once a project file has been created, it is possible to add other files to existing projects at any time. Adding bookmarks to selected parts of the project file helps to easily locate places in the file for quick review.

Reduce preparation time

When creating learning material with the Content Authoring Module, the teacher first selects a media file to function as the basis of the content project and can then freely add other elements, such as images, audio files, video and subtitles. When adding different elements to the media file the teacher can define the exact point in the media file when each element is to be displayed to students.

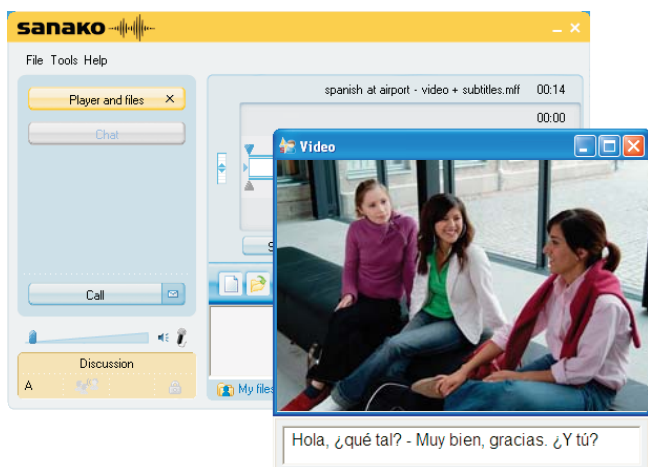
Subtitle audio and video to enhance learning

With the quick and easy text-synchronization feature teachers can create entertaining new learning material by subtitling audio or video. All the teacher has to do is to type a transcript or attach images to annotate the original content. Adding subtitles to a song or a video clip makes learning more effective, as students can view the written form of the content while listening to the audio.

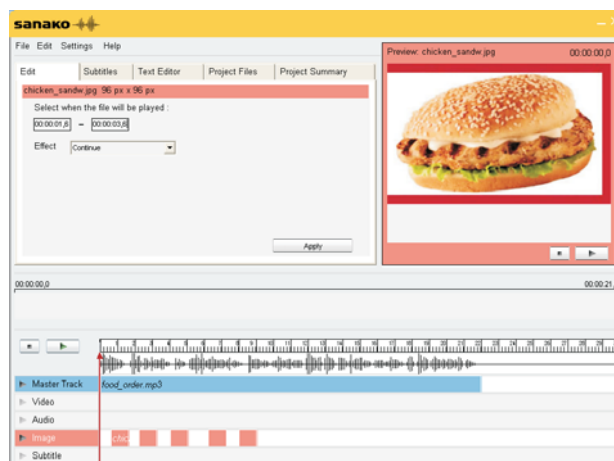


SANAKO Study Content Authoring Module

Tailor content for different skill levels

If the teacher wants to edit a saved project, she can open and edit the file at any point. This allows the same basic content material to be used with different students with as many modifications as needed. The teacher may also define whether to play only a part of the file or the entire file for students. The teacher can additionally define a point on the master track when the file will be played, whether the master track is paused while the additional file is played or whether the files are played simultaneously.

Preview content to ensure smooth lesson flow

The lesson flows smoothly when the teacher knows exactly what kind of material the students will work with. The "quick preview" function in the Study Content Authoring Module allows the teacher to play back either the entire project or a selected track on a preview screen before playing the material for students.

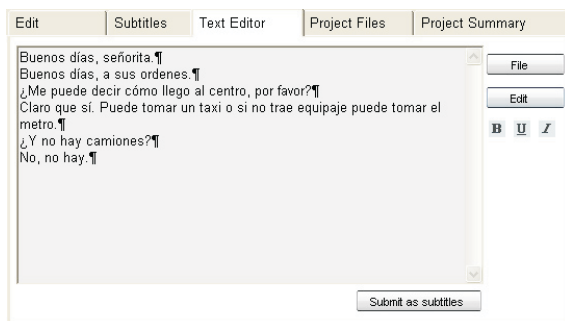
Quick access to content

Storing and searching for material using the Content Authoring Module is simple. Users can view general information in each content package, such as the name of the author, holder of copyright, date of creation, time of the latest modification and the total duration of the project. The information summary facilitates the sharing of the materials among teachers and helps with storing course materials for later use or editing.

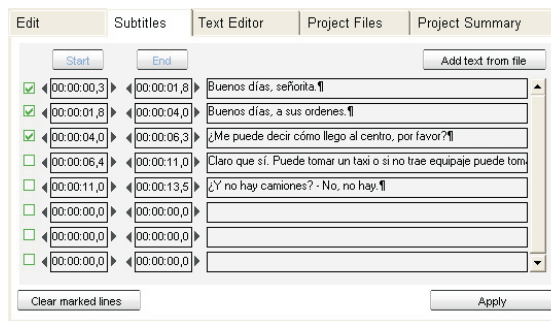
